The ideal candidate will be comfortable working in a collaborative, dynamic, and fast-paced environment and seeking to build their design portfolio.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and design content-driven graphics and layout for reports, brochures, flyers, social media graphics, workshops, marketing material, events, infographics, and digital content.
- Manage design print and digital files
- Manage printing process, including file prep, proofing, and press checks
- Quality check final printed products for color, dimensions, and quality integrity
- Color proof and edit photography
- Manage photo assets, including naming, numbering, etc.
- Support Communications Manager in production of digital marketing assets including video production, social media images and website
- Assist in maintenance and monitoring of implementation of organization's brand and guidelines for design standards across programs and portfolios
- Work independently as well as cooperatively with the team to meet deadlines on a wide range of projects
- Collaborate, brainstorm, and strategize with multiple teams on a wide range of materials that may include logos, brand systems, conference graphics and presentations, campaigns, and a range of other digital and print materials
- Participate in project meetings and provide creative input
- Occasional participation in events and other project related activities outside of normal office hours

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

Location: CPEX's office is located in downtown Baton Rouge and offers a flexible, dynamic work environment. After an initial fully-in-office period, CPEX employees may work some days remotely as the role allows. As a CPEX employee, the successful candidate will occasionally be expected to participate in CPEX meetings and events, occasionally on evenings and weekends with advance notice.

Compensation and Benefits: This is a full-time, salaried position with a competitive benefits package. Salary is anticipated to start at \$45,000 and will be commensurate with the successful candidate's level of experience.
